With a full house of bidders we let the Charolais breeders start us off. Seven Quarter Circle Charolais/ Bob & Nikki Miles enjoyed 5300.00 for RRMM RRR CHISUM 9C. Southside Charolais/Ken Rose had the high seller of the sale, SOUTHSIDE DAHLIA 10C soared to 7500.00. TK Cattle Company/Tate & Kolby Page watched TKCC BILLABONG 13B march to the tune of 5500.00. All together the Charolais average was 4990.00 on 7 bulls. We then moved on to the Simmental bulls with Crosby Cattle/Ron & Lois Crosby selling XBAR BLACK WALLBANGER 34C for 4000.00. 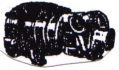

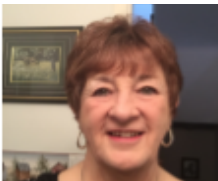
