Huge receipts this week in Kamloops as we showcased 1200 head of cattle. Yearlings were the largest number by far with incredible liner loads of top quality steers and heifers

Butcher bulls today rolled to action with **Ron & Margaret Franke** from McBride racing to 134.25. **John & Kate Anderson** saw their 1420 lb Butcher cows mark 97.00. **Doug Williams** from Vernon set a pace today showing 902 lb Angus steers at 169.25. **Ken MacDougall** with some of the heaviest steers in the sale, their 1059 lb steers notched 153.25, their 878 lb steers saw 171.50. **The Buse Creek Ranch** today started our Spay Heifer division as they showed 11 Spay Heifers 1024 lbs, they traded to 150.00, their 965 lb heifers raced to 161.50. You had to be there to watch this as the ring saw 140 powerful Spay Heifers in one group from **Copper Creek Cattle Co.** they raced to 160.75 and weighed 902 lbs. The next liner load of 802 lb Spay Heifers matched 161.75.

Phil & Shirley Johnston's 953 lb Char X steers sold to 170.75, their fancy 817 lb Tan heifers brought 164.75. **Rob & Arlene Smith's** 931 lb British steers traded to 168.50. **Patricia Deleurme's** 744 lb Heifers traded to 164.25, their 867 lb Heifers reached 159.00.

Thirty nine head of their 840 lb steers notched 179.50. A good pen of their 1393 lb Butcher Cows hit 99.00. **Pike Mountain Ranch's** 888 lb Black Angus steers hit 175.50

Joy Way Farms, the Zimmerman Family from McBride with a liner load of top cattle today. 30 head of their 886 lb steers marked 176.00. 17 head of their 844 lb fancy heifers raced to 165.75, their 830 lb steers raced to 179.50.

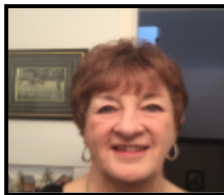

**IMPORTANT DEADLINE REMINDER FOR AGRISTABILITY
PRODUCERS AND TAX FILERS:**

The AgriStability administration would like to remind producers and tax filers that the deadline to submit your complete 2015 AgriStability/Agriharvest Harmonized form is September 30th, 2016.

What is AgriStability?

AgriStability is a business risk management program that protects producers against large declines in their net farming income. It is a margin based program. The current year margin is compared to the reference year. If there is a margin decline of 3% or more it could result in a benefit a payment being made to the producer.

The program year margin is the difference between allowable income and allowable expenses for the year.

The reference margin is the farm's average program margin for three of the past five years, the lowest and the highest are dropped from the calculation.
