We had a great time at our first yearling sale of the season. Despite all the smoke, over 700 feeders made it to town. We started off with a liner load of 903 lb AngusX steers in from Garrett Ranches (Vanderhoof) setting the pace at 174.50, 984 lb steers hit 165.00. Garretts also had 816 lb Hereford steers bring 178.00 and 914 lb Hereford steers sold at 173.50. Phil Klassen (Vanderhoof) did a great job on his grassers again, his 973 lb steers marked 167.00, 1035 lb steers at 168.50, 923 lb steers made 174.50. Phil also had heifers at 996 lb land on 160.00, 993 lb yearling heifers hit 162.00. Alex and Julie Kulchar (Vanderhoof) saw their 946 lb steers reach 173.00, they also had a 1455 lb cow top the butcher trade at 95.75. John Bree (Telkwa) in with good AngusX steers weighing 742 lb and finding a value of 196.00, 641 lb steers up to 206.75 and 576 Ib steers all the way to 208.50. Lone Fir Ranch (Fort Fraser) with top quality Hereford steers at 898 lb managed 176.75, 842 lb steers climbed to 179.00. Poole Farms (Vanderhoof) with strong Simmentals, at 819 lb their steers claimed 186.00, 704 lb Yearling steers up to 198.25, staying with Poole Farms we find 769 lb yearling heifers worth 182.50, 721 lb yearling heifers struck 185.00. Pooles also had 1448 lb butcher cows trade at 94.00. Bar K Ranch (PG) has 658 lb AngusX steers hit 206.75, 721 lb Hereford steers reached 196.50, 677 lb AngusX heifers marked 182.00, 756 lb yearling heifers at 174.25.lb The rising Canadian dollar and declining futures showed as the butcher trade faded some this week. Over 200 hd to choose from like the 1469 lb cows from Frank Larson (PG) brought 92.75. Lone Oak Ranch (Willow River) had 1563 lb cows notch 95.00. Golden Meadows Ranch (Fort Fraser) saw their 1599 lb cows reach 95.25. Woodpecker Ranch (Vanderhoof) with a Blk bull weighing 2050 lbs struck 121.50. Dave Johnson had a Red 2115 lb bull sell at 120.00. A high yielding Tan Bull from Alfred Horning (Burns Lake) weighed 2185 lbs and stopped the bid at \$122.25, Topping the bull trade was Rafter C Ranch (PG) with a 2020 lb tan bull demanding \$123.50. A great day was had by all. Thank you to the crew for keeping it running. Great job by the producers on the powerful cattle we sometimes take for granted here. Most of all thank you to the buyers and truckers for making the extra effort to come around all the fires and accident scenes through the weekend. Our thoughts and prayers go out to those in the midst of the devastation. Next regular sale in Vanderhoof is August 25th, 600—800 head expected.

Beef Cattle Check-Off increasing to \$5 per head effective September 1, 2017

DELAYED TO 2018

The cattle industry in British Columbia is supporting the increase in check-off to \$5.00 per head beginning September 1, 2017. This \$5 represents both provincial and national check-off amounts. The Canadian Beef Cattle Check-off is increasing to \$2.50 per head and at the same time, the provincial check-off is increasing to \$2.50. These increases were made at the request of the provincial and national cattle associations.

CANADIAN BEEF CATTLE CHECK-OFF \$2.50 (National)

The five-year Canada's *National Beef Strategy* recommended the increase to the national check-off, noting that the \$1 approved in 1999 just didn't go far enough in today's economy. The \$2.50 national check-off (non-refundable) is allocated by each province and must meet the regulations that allow the check-off to be used to promote the marketing and production of beef cattle, beef and beef products and to conduct and promote research activities related to those products. *https://canadabeef.ca/national-check-off/*

CIDC CHECK-OFF \$2.50 (Provincial)

The provincial check-off is increasing by 50¢ per head for \$2.50 provincial (refundable) check-off. This increase will be put to use by the provincial cattle associations for projects that benefit the BC beef industry. The cattle herd numbers have continued to decline resulting in decreased check-off receipts. In consultation with the cattle industry in BC, CIDC felt it would benefit the beef industry in BC to increase the provincial check-off. Every dollar paid in check-off in BC is matched by the Beef Cattle Industry Development Fund for investment into the cattle industry. http://www.cattlefund.net
